Bring on the spring weather! We are hopeful that Mother Nature is kind and allows us to have a nice spring for once! The course is slowly losing the snow and it looks pretty good so far. A little sunshine and warmth and we will be ready for the season!

Highlights for the upcoming season:

- Good Friday Special! 18 holes with a cart, a hot dog or polish dog and 2 drink tickets all for \$25, please call for tee times. (Weather Permitting)
- Last fall we added covers to a several of our carts and they will be available on those “iffy” days for a cost of \$10 per cart.
- Over the winter we had a pond installed in front of the ladies tee on #3 to help alleviate ongoing drainage issues. We also added some drain pipe on #10 & #17 which should also help with ongoing problems.
- We will be offering a Mother’s day brunch this year. Last year we hired a new Chef and we are very excited to showcase her talents. We will be offering a variety of hot breakfast/luncheon entrees, including an omelet station, a waffle/pancake station, desserts and much more! We will have seatings at 10:00 and 12:00. Reservations are required and can be made by calling (810) 798-3971. The cost will be \$16 per adult and \$8 per child 5-12, 4 & under are free.
- Anyone that purchases a single, couple or family membership will now have the option of adding a cart for \$300 per person for the season. It will entitle the member to unlimited cart use for the entire 2010 season, offering the potential for substantial savings. The use of the driving range is now included in these memberships as well.
- We are instituting a discount punch card for this season. The cards will be for 10 rounds of 18 holes with a cart, good for weekdays only. The cost will be \$199 for seniors (55 & over) and \$249 for non-seniors.
- The GAM fee for 2010 will again be \$25. For those of you who are not familiar with it, we offer a handicapping program through the Golf Association of Michigan (GAM). All you have to do is fill out a short form in the pro shop, pay the fee and start posting scores. Once you have posted 5 or more 18 hole rounds or 10 or more 9 hole rounds, a handicap can be computed. Every 2 weeks the scores are sent in and you will receive a new handicap. Your GAM card will also get you discounts at certain golf courses as well as allow you to play in our Club

Championship on August 8th. If you would like additional information on this program, you can visit their website at www.gam.org

- We will again be holding a Junior Golf Clinic in June. Participants learn the basics and fundamentals of etiquette, chipping, putting and full shots. It is open to children ages 8 to 18 and space is limited. Contact the pro shop if you would like to be added to our mailing list.
- We will be offering an additional junior playing program that will be on Wednesdays throughout July (7/7, 14, 21, 28) from 7:15 AM to 10 AM. They will play 9 holes of golf if time permits.
